Here is an overview of the learning goals for this week:

**Spelling:** Words that 'wr' making the 'r' sound like in wrist. 'kn' making the 'n' sound like in knot.

Reading: Our novel is Midnight on the Moon. This is a Magic Treehouse book by Mary Pope Osborne. During Centers will be reading about Human Rights and Famous People who have effected Human Rights in our nation.

Language: Complete simple sentences with a noun, verb, adverb, and adjective. Knowing the difference between a noun and verb, and what question the adjective is answering. Knowing our Synonyms, Antonyms, and Homonyms.

**Math:** Subtraction with regrouping (borrowing). We will be subtracting 2 double digit numbers.





$$11 + 4 = 15$$


$$15 - 11 = 4$$

$$4 + 11 = 15$$


$$15 - 4 = 11$$




