### Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Here is an overview of the learning goals for this week:

**Spelling:** Words that include the 'ch' and 'wh' phonograms.

**Writing:** D'Nealian Handwriting and 5 Sentence Complete Paragraphs. We will be presenting our final drafts of our superhero upstander stories.

Reading: Comprehension, identifying characters, setting, plot, beginning, middle, and end. We are reading tall tales. We have read Paul Bunyan, John Henry, and Casey Jones. This week we will read Pecos Bill.

Language: Complete simple sentences with a noun, verb, and adverb. Knowing the difference between a noun and verb, and what question the adverb is answering.

Math: Subtracting single digits using a variety of strategies.

**Social Studies:** 5 Ways to deal with a Bully and 10 Ways to be an upstander.


