Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Here is an overview of the learning goals for this week:

Spelling: Words that include the 'er, and 'or' phonograms.

Writing: D'Nealian Handwriting and 5 Sentence Complete Paragraphs. We will be writing reflections as read through our first novel, *Freckle Juice*, by Judy Blume.

Reading: Predictions, Cause and Effect, and Character Traits in the novel *Freckle Juice*, by Judy Blume.

Language: Complete simple sentences with a noun, verb, adverb, and adjective. Knowing the difference between a noun and verb, and what question the adverb is answering.

Math: Number Patterns; 2's, 5's, and 10's. Using arrays to create multiplication and repeated addition problems.

Book in a Bag-Daily Homework: Please return each day. I often have volunteers to read with your students if they were unable to read it at home.


*If the homework packet is returned on Friday your student is given a star on the homework chart and they receive a reward ticket.
