Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Here is an overview of the learning goals for this week:

Spelling: Words that have long 'o' from 'oa' and 'oe' as in goat and toe.

Writing: D'Nealian Handwriting and 5 Sentence Complete Paragraphs. Paragraphs that are written with evidence from research on the moon.

Reading: Recall, character analysis, cause and effect.

Language: Complete simple sentences with a noun, verb, adverb, and adjective. Knowing the difference between a noun and verb, and what question the adjective is answering.

Math: Telling Time

Social Studies: Moon; landforms, atmosphere, its connection to Earth.

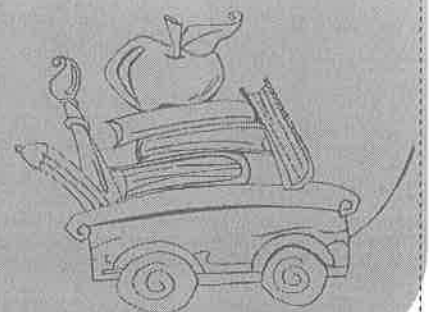

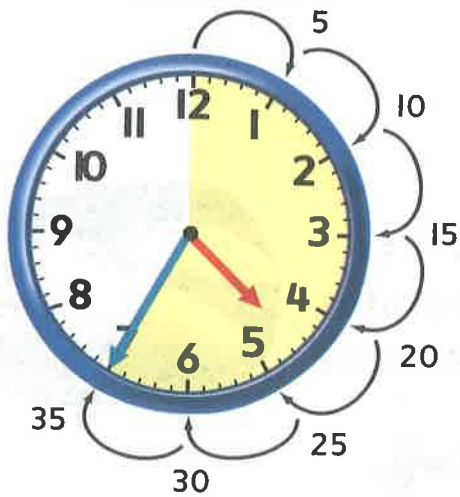
Time to Five-Minute Intervals

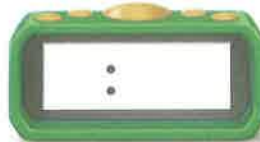
