9/30 (Mon.): 5:30 p.m. Literacy Night with a special performance of the 'Twits', by Roald Dahl.

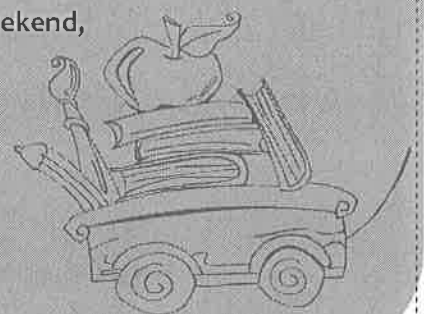
